No stamp required
if posted in Australia

It's simple. Do it now.

1. Take the battery out of your old mobile and cover the points with tape.
2. Place your old mobile, battery and any other old chargers or accessories separately in the box your new mobile came in or any other box or envelope handy to you.
3. Seal it and stick this address label on it.
4. Read and complete Sender's Details and Dangerous Goods Declaration.
5. Drop it in the post free anywhere in Australia.



Mobile phone batteries, chargers and accessories are all accepted.

MobileMuster is the official recycling program of the Mobile Phone industry and run as a not-for-profit program. All recycling of components is to the highest environmental standards. None of the mobiles are sold for reuse.

Aviation Security and Dangerous Goods Declaration. I, the sender, declare that:

1. I have separated the battery from the handset
2. Placed the battery and the handset separately in the package and sealed the article
3. Completed sender's details
4. This article does not contain dangerous or prohibited goods e.g. explosives, flammables, corrosives, aerosol, etc and acknowledge that the article may be carried by air
5. Articles without this declaration completed may be returned to sender
