PLANNING YOUR EVENT.

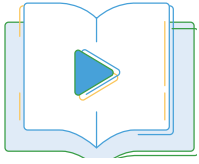
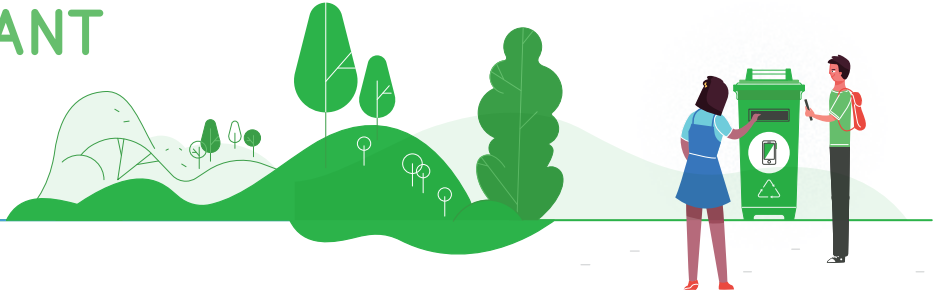
- Have you booked in your MobileMuster collection for recycling?

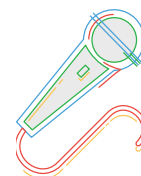
Conduct a survey to see how many old mobile phones people are storing at home.
