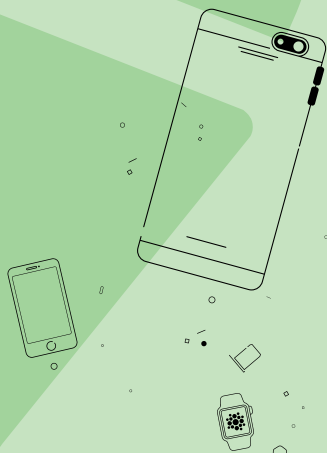

Is voluntarily funded by all the major handset manufacturers and network carriers.



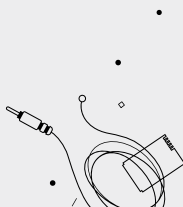
Is a free and secure mobile phone recycling program in Australia managed to the highest environmental standard.

Why recycling matters

Carbon neutral

When you recycle with MobileMuster it is 100% carbon neutral. We are committed to reducing our carbon emissions and where necessary offsetting all the emissions associated with the product stewardship program. It means that all our operations have net zero carbon impact.



Environmental benefits

The environmental benefit of recycling mobile phones is gained from avoiding future greenhouse gas emissions, saving energy, protecting the environment and conserving natural resources.

Recycling improves air quality by reducing the demand for power used in the mining, refining, processing and shipping of raw materials. Through recycling we also prevent potentially hazardous materials from entering the environment.

Circular economy

We believe our role is to enhance the collection system of unwanted phones, support repair and reuse programs to increase the lifespan of mobiles, improve the material recovery in the recycling process and reduce the number of phones in storage.

Ensuring data security

Before you recycle, sell or give away your mobile phone, you should remove your personal information. If your mobile phone is still working, follow our steps for managing data on your device.



1. Unpair all external accessories

2. Back up your device

3. Log out of all your accounts

4. Perform a reset

5. Remove the SIM card and any external storage if you want to keep it

Remember instructions can vary depending on your mobile phone. If you need help, look up the phone manufacturers website.

If your phone is damaged and you're unable to remove the data, as part of the recycling process MobileMuster will destroy any data left on the device.

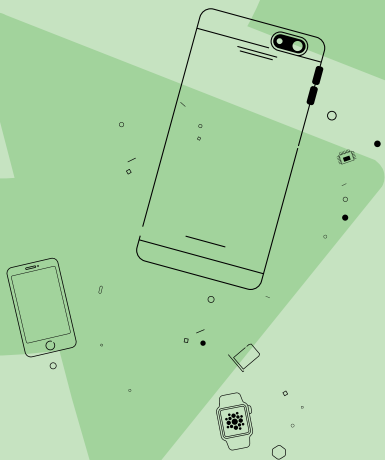


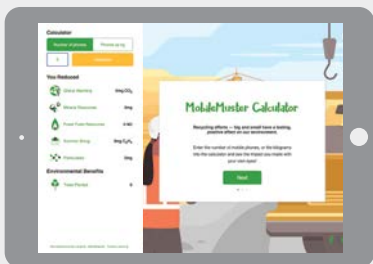

What happens to a phone when it is recycled?

When MobileMuster receives your old phone it is dismantled and the components processed to maximize recovery rates. The program is accredited by the Federal Government and ensures that everything is recycled in an environmentally responsible manner.

All the metal, glass and plastic used to make your mobile phone has the potential for a second life. The program recovers over 95% of the material from old phones and accessories, which are then used in the manufacturing of new products. This process reduces the impact of mobile phones on the environment by avoiding future greenhouse gas emissions, saving energy and conserving our natural resources.
